**THIRD THIRTY NETWORK**—Dr. Janet Miller is the Chair of the “Third Thirty Network” for the Presbytery of the Miami Valley. The network is referring to the third thirty years of a person’s life. Dr. Miller is completing her Older Adult Ministry Certificate at Columbia Theological Seminary to obtain even more familiarity on the wonderful, fascinating journey of aging. She is a member of Bath Presbyterian Church and the Presbyterian Older Adult Ministry Network (POAMN). She volunteers in various ways with Habitat for Humanity and with Bella Hospice Care. Dr. Miller is a retired USAF officer living in Dayton, Ohio. Her research and program management area was human factors, a combination of psychology, computer science and engineering. In particular, she published on knowledge elicitation, the process of prompting information from an expert to obtain more understanding on the topic. Since retiring, Janet has begun using these skills for gaining knowledge on aging issues and older adult matters. We welcome her leadership presenting information about the Third Thirty Network on Sunday, October 13.

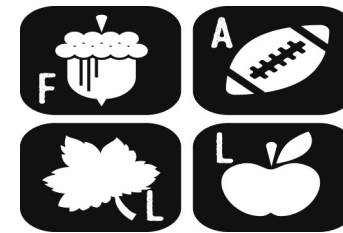
